Examples of How We Can Help Your Business...

Problem: A health & safety consulting and training company needed better communication among employees with features such as shared calendars and project information. In addition, various remote options were needed for employees working in several other offices or on the road. All employees needed to have a secure way to connect in from where ever they were and have access to all of the features available in the office.

Solution: A Cisco firewall with secure remote access was installed with a Microsoft Small Business Server. This server not only shares files securely, but it includes Microsoft Exchange Mail Server for sharing of resources and remote access to desktops in the office. Customer has approximately 25 PCs connecting in from various parts of NJ & PA. They have been a customer since 1999.

Problem: A manufacturing company was sharing files among several computers. They were moving to a new location and they wanted to ensure better control and backups of the files. In addition, they would spend a week creating a special report that their accounting software could not generate but the information was very important to help run their business.

Solution: A Windows Server 2008 was installed with an array of hard drives so if one failed the system continues to run. With the files in a centralized protected server, it was also easier to back them up. Furthermore, a custom program was written that reads the data from the accounting software and creates the report in seconds!

Problem: A hacker compromised an old server in a law firm and was using it to send out what ever they wanted, not only slowing down the server but Internet access for everyone and threatening their data. Microsoft said it was compromised so badly that only redoing the entire server would guarantee that it was once again secure.

Solution: ASIS, LLC was hired. We began working on it first by installing a quality hardware firewall and since it was an old server, it was decided that the entire server would be replaced . A server-based antivirus was installed where the server makes sure that the workstations have up to date antivirus as well.
